### **ABOUT THE CONFERENCE**

The **2010 International Conference on Emergency Management** is a common initiative on behalf of the State Council of the People's Republic of China, together with the Ministry of Public Security, the Ministry of Civil Affairs, the Ministry of Health, the State Administration of Work Safety, and the Chinese Academy of Governance as the leading office. The Deutsche Gesellschaft für Technische Zusammenarbeit (GTZ) GmbH will act as the co-organizer of the conference.

The People's Republic of China is prone to many types of natural hazards which are characterized through extensive geographical distribution, high frequency, severe ferocity and extensive losses. In early 2008, the south of China experienced a serious sleet and snow disaster rarely seen in the past century, and in May of the same year a devastating earthquake hit Wenchuan, Sichuan Province, claiming heavy loss of lives and severe damages to livelihoods and the local economy. Only recently, on 14 April 2010, more than 2,000 people died in an earthquake in Yushu, Qinghai Province. Meanwhile, China is prone to many industry accidents and threats to public health, all inducing severe economic losses. According to different estimations the losses amount between six and eight percent of the GDP.

Many other countries are also affected by natural disasters, terrorist attacks, and public health emergencies, such as recently experienced by the Haiti and Chile earthquake, the explosive incident of Moscow subway, and the H1N1 pandemic.

This conference therefore focuses on experiences and approaches in the field of emergency management, and on different countries perspectives on how to prepare, respond to and recover from disasters.

Furthermore it aims to provide a high-level interactive platform and to strengthen the international cooperation.
